<u>Hatching History: A WATT collection of rare poultry breed portraits</u>, a select showing of pieces from the WATT collection of poultry breed paintings (1926-1950).

The complete collection is comprised of 57 framed oil paintings created by three American artists, A.O. Schilling, L. Stahmer and F.L. Sewell, and was commissioned by J.W. Watt, founder of Watt Publishing Company in the mid-1920s. Approximately 15 of these paintings will be on display at Rockford Art Museum (RAM) Art Annex.
